PURSUENT TO SECTION 20 of the Forest and Range Practices Act, S.B.C. 2002, c.69, the following Amendments are made to the Forest Stewardship Plan:

5. SCC Order Objective 8 – Important Fisheries Watershed Result or Strategy is added as follows:

***SCC Order Objective 8 – Important Fisheries Watershed***

FDU	Result or Strategy
FDU 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8	1. If the Holder of this FSP constructs a road or harvests a cutblock within the area to which <i>Ministerial Order South Central Coast, Schedule 3</i> applies, the Holder will do so maintaining an equivalent clearcut area of less than 20% in important fisheries watersheds

6. SCC Order Objective 12 – Upland Streams Result or Strategy is added as follows:

***SCC Order Objective 12 – Upland Streams***

FDU	Result or Strategy
FDU 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8	1. If the Holder of this FSP constructs a road or harvests a cutblock within the area to which <i>Ministerial Order South Central Coast, Schedule 3</i> applies, the Holder will do so consistent with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) not harvesting more than 30% of the forest, in the portion of the watershed occupied by upland streams; and</li> <li>b) allocating functional riparian forest retention to include identified occurrences of upland stream reaches with identified unique microclimate or other ecological or geomorphic characteristics.</li> </ul>

7. Objectives Set by Government for Fish Habitat in Fisheries Sensitive Watersheds (FPPR 8.1)

The Result or Strategy for fisheries sensitive watersheds is amended as follows:

***“No Fisheries Sensitive Watersheds are included within FDU 1 and 2 as identified in Schedule 2 of the FPPR.”*** is deleted and replaced with;

***“No Fisheries Sensitive Watersheds are included within any FDU as identified in Schedule 2 of the FPPR.”***

8. Objectives Set by Government for Water in Community Watersheds (FPPR 8.2)

The Result or Strategy for Community Watersheds is amended as follows:

***“No community watersheds are included within FDU 1 and 2.”*** is deleted and replaced with;

***“The Holder of this FSP will not construct a road or harvest a cutblock within a designated community watershed.”***

9. Measures to Prevent the Introduction & Spread of Invasive Plants

The following paragraph is added as preventative measures to combat the introduction and spread of invasive plant species;

***“Logging and road construction contractors will be directed to inspect and remove shrub vegetation from logging/road construction equipment, and dispose of the vegetation in a manner that will prevent the further introduction or spread of species of plants that are considered invasive under the Invasive Plants Regulation.”***

10. Appendix 1 Stocking Standards

Non-Replaceable Forest License A87259 is added to Appendix 1.0 section 2.1.

Section 2.0 has been amended to include biogeoclimatic (BEC) variants: CWHds2 and CWHvm1.

Section 2.1 has been amended to include a six regeneration delay for all BEC variants.
